Seeing what you can do:

Structured Paragraphing II (format)



Promise: statement of intent, stand on a issue (no "I" or "I think".) **One sentence**

Definition: defines the topic. **One sentence**

Hook/Transition: aims to guide reader to the examples -

if you start negatively, you end up positively

(and vice versa)

One Sentence

Lead In: a little sentence that sets up the examples. Used to set **One Sentence**

the examples in a context

Examples: THREE examples are given with TWO supporting points for each example.

Transition words are used to help make the examples flow from one to another.

Nine sentences

Reminder: reminds the reader of your main points. Your final stab at the truth!

One sentence

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
